From The Mayor

NYS DOT has responded to my request to review the intersection of South Ave and Route 5 & 20 (State St.). Their review included a 10 year crash study and documentation of roadway characteristics. As a result, the intersection will be upgraded to emphasize the stop condition on South Ave. Oversized stop signs will be installed, along with additional signs on the driver's left both north and south. Timing for this upgrade will be determined by the state.

There has been an increase in speeding within the Village. I reached out to the Sheriff's office with a request for help with this issue. They responded by saying increased road patrols and radar will be assigned in an attempt to address these concerns.

Main Street paving is scheduled for this summer. We are waiting for a definite date from the contractor.

Rabies Clinics

Because we have documented rabies in our county, New York State Law requires every dog, cat, and ferret at least 3 months of age be vaccinated against rabies at all times. Each year Ontario County Public Health provides six free rabies clinics throughout the county. The 2021 rabies clinics run from 9AM-Noon and are scheduled for the following dates and: **August 7th, September 11th, and October 16th**. All clinics will be held at the Ontario County Public Works at 2962 County Road 48 in Canandaigua. **All attending the clinic are required to wear a mask.** Clinics are FREE but donations are appreciated. Dogs, Cats and ferrets must be healthy and at least 12 weeks old. Bring your most recent rabies certificate with you if possible. Pets must be on a leash or in a carrier. Annual Water Quality Report

The Village is required by the Dept. of Health to have the water tested regularly throughout the year. We are also required to submit an annual report summarizing the water testing results. The annual report for 2020 is complete and you can find it on the Village website. Copies are also available at the Village office. You will be pleased to know that our water is not in violation of any contaminant levels, including lead; and meets all DOH Standards.

Flushing Hydrants

The Village DPW will be flushing hydrants in July/August. It is normal for the water to appear a little cloudy after flushing the system so just let the water run for a few minutes and it should clear right up.

Veterans Park

Thank you to everyone who helped support the building of the pavilion, at Veterans Park. The dedication ceremony took place on May 15th.

Veterans Park/Elton Park

The Veterans Park-American Legion Building and new pavilion are open for events. The American Legion Building has two rooms or you can reserve the entire facility. The Pavilion is also available for reservations.

Elton Park is required to be reserved for large groups over 25 people. Both Elton Park and Veterans Park are carry-in/carry-out parks.

For reservations, call the **Town of East Bloomfield** Clerk's office at 585- 657-7700. You must provide a valid driver's license and Vehicle Registration.

Boughton Park

As a Village resident you are allowed to use Boughton Park. To use the Park you must have a valid Boughton Park Vehicle Tag. You must provide a valid driver's license and vehicle registration. Building Permits

Summer is upon us and just a reminder that building permits are needed for additions, remodels, decks, porches, roofs, pools, sheds, and permanent pergolas. Projects that don't need a permit are patios, sidewalks, garden boxes, dirt to fill uneven ground or holes and a new driveway. Recycle Medications

The **East Bloomfield Town Hall** located at 99 Main St. in the Village is an official drop-off location for medicine that is no longer needed or outdated and needs to be discarded. A secure, locked box is located in the public meeting room at the Town Hall.
